


Vogue Gyratory transport improvements Programme of Works

Construction work to improve the safety of the Vogue Gyratory begins on **14 July 2014**.

Work includes new traffic signals, an improved bus stop, a northbound cycle lane, better pedestrian crossings and footways.

To minimise disruption to residents and journeys, the work will be completed in three phases, over a 20 week period. The proposed work schedule is shown on the map opposite.

Phase 1
14 July until mid-August

Localised footway works in the centre of the gyratory – restricted pedestrian access.

No road closures.

Access to all properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Phase 2
Mid-August until mid-October

Temporary closure of Upper Lewes Road (east) at the Lewes Road junction.

Temporary on-demand pedestrian crossings while old signal equipment is removed at the southern end.

Partial restriction of the northbound carriageway to a single traffic lane to permit new wide footway works up to and including the entrance to Sainsbury's.

The Sainsbury's bus stop will be suspended.

Pedestrian & vehicle access to Sainsbury's and BP station will be maintained throughout the work.

Phase 3
Mid-October until early December

Temporary closure of Bear Road at the Lewes Road junction for approximately two weeks while traffic signals are upgraded.

Temporary closure of access to Upper Lewes Road continues.

Localised footway works and pedestrian island improvements.

Advice during the work for:

Pedestrians

We will need to temporarily suspend some of the pedestrian crossings. Safe alternative pedestrian routes will be provided and you will be able to access all properties in the area during the work.

All businesses and services in the area will be open as usual.

Cyclists

Traffic lanes will be suspended and short sections of the cycle lane may be closed. Cyclists are advised to:

- Treat all roadworks as a hazard and use normal techniques to safely overtake or pass obstructions
- If the road is narrowed, ride as you would on a road of similar width, but allow for the possibility of surface damage and obstacles

Bus passengers

From mid-August, the bus stop outside Sainsbury's will be closed. To access Sainsbury's, please use either the Melbourne Street or Lewes Road Bus Garage stops.

The bus stop will be re-opened as soon as possible. However, this phase of the work may take up to two months to complete.

Motorists

The road closures in Phases 2 & 3 are essential to ensure that the work is completed as quickly as possible.

There will inevitably be some delays and motorists are advised to seek alternative routes where possible.

The existing 20mph speed limit will remain in force.

Vehicle access to Sainsbury's and BP filling station will be maintained throughout the work.
