ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ("the Council") proposes to make the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce various changes as detailed below:

Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.* 202* (ref: TRO-49a-2023)

Introduce new electric vehicle charging points for permit holders only (Maximum Stay 24 hours – No return within 12 hours) in:-

- Zone C - Blaker Street, Broad Street, Freshfield Street & Upper Bedford Street
- Zone F - Ditchling Road
- Zone H – Arundel Street, Belle Vue Gardens, Sudeley Street & Walpole Terrace
- Zone J - Cleveland Road, Edburton Avenue, Florence Road & Rugby Road
- Zone L - St Leonard's Road
- Zone M - Brunswick Square, Cambridge Road & York Road
- Zone O - Furze Hill
- Zone Q - Hamilton Road & York Villas
- Zone R - Prinsep Road
- Zone S - Elm Grove & Freshfield Road
- Zone V - Ewart Street

Existing charging point to be changed to permit holders only (Maximum Stay 24 hours – No return within 12 hours) in:-

- Zone H –Bloomsbury Place & Marine Square
- Zone O - Lorna Road

Existing charging point to be changed to 8am to 8pm for a maximum of 4 hours (no return within 4 hours) in:-

- Zone H –Arundel Road & Portland Place

Proposed new Shared Permit or Paid Parking Places in:-

- Zone C - Cuthbert Road & St Luke's Road
- Zone F - Ashford Road
- Zone H - St George's Road & Sudeley Street
- Zone J - Rugby Road

Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment No.* 202* (ref: TRO-49b-2023)

Introduce new electrical vehicle charging point at any time - Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours) in:-

- Batemans Road, Kipling Avenue, Roedale Road & Stanmer Villas
