

**BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

Brighton & Hove (Conway Street) (One-Way) Order 202* (TRO-1c-2024)

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the above named Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Conway Street) (One-Way) Order 202* and shall come into operation on the ** day of ***** 202*.

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions;

"Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 as amended from time to time

3. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit a vehicle except a Pedal Cycle to proceed in those roads or lengths of road specified in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 below other than in the direction specified in column 4.
