BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Brighton & Hove (Conway Street) (One-Way) Order 202* (TRO-1c-2024)

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") as amended and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the above named Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Conway Street) (One-Way) Order 202* and shall come into operation on the ** day of ******* 202*.
- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-
 - "Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions;
 - "Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 as amended from time to time
- 3. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit a vehicle except a Pedal Cycle to proceed in those roads or lengths of road specified in columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 below other than in the direction specified in column 4.
