



DECISION ON DESIGNATION OF A NEIGHBOURHOOD FORUM HOVE STATION NEIGHBOURHOOD FORUM

Background

On 18 September 2014 Brighton & Hove City Council's Economic Development & Culture Committee ("the Committee"):

- 1) designated the Hove Station Neighbourhood Area as a neighbourhood area within the meaning of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act"); and
- 2) authorised the Head of Planning & Public Protection (now the Head of City Planning & Development) to designate the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum as a neighbourhood forum within the meaning of the Act subject to:
 - a) being satisfied that the neighbourhood forum met the statutory criteria set out in section 61F (5) of the Act; and
 - b) seeking agreement as to how the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum would engage with people, groups and forums in adjacent areas and take their views into account in the drafting of any neighbourhood development plan

Documentation

The Constitution of the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum supplied to the Council on the 23 December 2014 ("the Constitution") provides that the Forum meets the statutory criteria set out in section 61F (5) of the Act.

The letter dated 8 December 2014 sent by the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum to the Chairman of the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum ("the letter"), a copy of which was supplied to the Council on the same date, evidences how the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum intends to work with the Hove Park Neighbourhood Forum in addressing common issues.

Delegated decision

The Head of City Planning & Development is satisfied that the requirements of 2 a) and b) above have been met by the submission of the Constitution and the letter and hereby exercises the authority granted to him by the Committee

to designate the Hove Station Neighbourhood Forum as a neighbourhood forum for the purposes of the Act.
