Disposal of cremated remains

Note: No use of chapel, includes

- > The Medical Referee's fee
- > Mercury Abatement supplement
- > All attendances after the coffin has been placed on the catafalque
- > Temporary container for the removal or despatch of cremated remains
- > The retention of the cremated remains for up to three months after cremation
- > Witness strewing of cremated remains by appointment only

- > Use of chapel (for a maximum of 30 minutes) and organ (if required),
- > Use of waiting room facilities and viewing of tributes
- > The provision of recorded music for the service

Note: All graves are subject to availability. The Purchase of the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial is for a period of 50 years. All Rights of Ownership can be purchased in advance, if required. Should a coffin be larger than the grave space requested, then an adjoining grave space may need to be purchased in order to accommodate the burial, and appropriate additional charges made. The Exclusive Right of Burial can be extended for a further 25 years after the initial grant has expired. The fee for this service will be one half of the purchase fee at the time of renewal.

Interment - This can only be arranged where the exclusive right of burial has been purchased

Cemetery fees for Non-residents

All the cemetery fees will be **doubled** unless the person to be interred at the time of death or the person acquiring the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial was a resident of Brighton and Hove.

Residential status includes

- > Resided in Brighton & Hove (paid Council Tax for local services provided by Brighton & Hove City Council)
- > Resided in the Parishes of Peacehaven or Telscombe (subject to review)
- > Resided outside the city, only following placement by the council's Adult Social Care department
- > In the case of a child, where either parent was a resident of the city
- > Any named person, on the written authority of the Brighton & Hove Hebrew Congregation
- > Any resident who purchased the Exclusive Right of Burial prior to interment
- > Any person who has paid Council Tax for a minimum of 5 years and has subsequently moved
Proof of payment will be required.
