Brackenbury Primary is a welcoming and inclusive school, with a strong sense of community and a commitment to improving outcomes for all children. The governing body of Brackenbury Primary School currently has vacancies for co-opted governors.

We are looking for someone with enthusiasm, time and flexibility to contribute effectively to the role. You do not need to be an expert in education: our board is made up of governors with a range of experience and expertise.

We play an important part in raising school standards through our three key roles of setting strategic direction, ensuring accountability and monitoring and evaluating school performance. As a board, we actively engage with the school, to enable us to effectively provide support and challenge to the Headteacher and the leadership team.

The Full Governing Board meets approximately 6 times a year, and we currently have 2 committees which meet termly, as well as a number of monitoring roles allocated to individual governors.

All governors are encouraged to attend the high quality local authority and online training to help them develop in their role. There is also a full induction programme for new governors.
