on 2 September 2016 at 9.30am for an Order under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the stopping up of an area of the highway being an area measuring 6 metres in width and 6 metres in depth situated in CENTURION ROAD BRIGHTON adjacent to the rear of the property know as 45 CHURCH STREET BRIGHTON shown coloured blue on the attached plan on the ground that the highway is unnecessary.
