

# DEATH REGISTRATION

## IMPORTANT NOTICE – PLEASE READ

During the registration you will be asked to check and sign that the information you have given the registrar has been recorded correctly.

It is **your** responsibility to ensure that there are no mistakes – this includes spelling mistakes.

A death registration is a legal document and therefore it is important that it is accurate.

Errors discovered **after** you have signed the register may have to be corrected. This could cause delays to funeral arrangements and processing of the deceased's affairs.

**Please note** that some corrections will be shown on the certificate – you will not always receive a new 'clean' certificate.
