LICENSING OF HOUSES IN MULTIPLE OCCUPATION (HMOs)

NOTICE is hereby given that on 15 November 2017 Brighton & Hove City Council (the council) revoked the designation made under section 56(1) of the Housing Act 2004 (the Act) on 17 June 2015, designating the area in its district comprising the Wards of Brunswick & Adelaide, Central Hove, East Brighton, Goldsmid, Preston Park, Regency and Westbourne as subject to additional licensing in relation to HMOs consisting of two or more storeys and with three or more occupiers, other than those that are HMOs by virtue of Section 257 of the Act.

The designation is being revoked as a new designation was made on the 15 November 2017 bringing the area into a new citywide Additional Licensing Scheme with effect from 1 March 2018.

The revocation will take effect from midnight on 28 February 2018.
