

New extended Zone C (Formerly Zone U) FAQ's

What's happening?

Zone U will be changing and the roads currently in Zone U will, from Monday 3rd June, be part of Zone C. The operational hours will be Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm.

What do I do with my existing Zone U permit? (Including residents, businesses, visitor and school)

Just continue to use your permit as usual until it expires. When you come to renew it, you will be issued a Zone C permit.

Will the permit cost the same?

No, Zone C is a full scheme which operates everyday 9am to 8pm and the permits have different costs – please see the Zone C webpage or below for permit costs

Can I still park using a ticket obtained from a machine located within a different street in Zone C?

Yes – so long as the tariff and maximum stay times are the same - for example – 2 hours, 4 hours or 11 hours.

Can visitors pay to park and how much will it cost?

Yes, there will be 2 hour, 4 hour and 11 hour paid parking available – please check signs on-street. The current tariffs are shown within the table below:

Length of stay (up to)	Tariff
1 hour	£1.00
2 hours	£2.00
4 hours	£4.00
11 hours	£5.50

There will be **no** pay and display machines and the parking must be paid for via pay by phone or at a PayPoint location.
