

Notice of Full Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2019

Brighton & Hove City Council gives notice that a full review of polling districts and polling places across Brighton & Hove is to be conducted.

The (Acting) Returning Officer will comment on the suitability of proposed changes to polling stations and places within each affected polling district. These will be available for viewing on the council website www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/vote and at the Electoral Services Office.

Written comments and representations are invited from any registered electors within Brighton & Hove, elected representatives and local political parties, as well as persons and organisations that have particular expertise in relation to access to premises and facilities for people who have different forms of disability. Any comments should include, where appropriate, alternative venue suggestions that may be used as polling places.
