The Council is the data controller for purposes of the Data Protection Act (1998) and EU General Data Protection Regulation as of May 2018 and is registered as a data controller with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) under registration number Z5840053.

Brighton and Hove City Council are committed to protecting your personal information. As a data controller we have a responsibility to make sure you know why and how your personal information is being collected in accordance with relevant data protection law.

### **Why we are processing your data**

- We are collecting your data for the purpose of making you aware of planning matters in the city.
- We have a legal basis for collecting this data under Explicit Consent and you will be required to provide Consent below.

- Your information will not be shared with any other third party without you being informed.
- We will hold your data for 6 years under the Limitation Act 1980
