



## **Governor Vacancy Stanford Infant School**

Stanford Infant School is a three form entry school from Reception to Year Two, where we deliver a rich and creative curriculum to inspire and excite every child and celebrate diversity. We play an important part in raising school standards through our three key roles of setting strategic direction, ensuring accountability and monitoring and evaluating school performance. As a board, we actively engage with the school, to enable us to effectively provide support and challenge to the Headteacher and the leadership team.

The Full Governing Board meets approximately 6 times a year as well as a number of monitoring roles allocated to working groups.

All governors are encouraged to attend the high quality local authority and online training to help them develop in their role. There is also a full induction programme for new governors.
