

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL**

**Brighton & Hove (Argyle Road) Various Restrictions Experimental Order 2020**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Argyle Road) (Various Restrictions Experimental Order 2020 and shall come into operation on the 24th day of July 2020.
2. The Council's Executive Director Economy, Environment & Culture or any person authorised by him is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-
  - "**Emergency services vehicle**" means a vehicle operated by the police, fire & rescue service or ambulance service;
  - "**Motor Vehicle**" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads subject to Section 20 Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;
  - "**Pedal cycle**" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated or re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
6. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in those parts of road specified in columns 2 and 3 in Schedule 1 other than;
  - (a) A Vehicle being used in the course of an emergency by Emergency services vehicles
  - (b) a pedal cycle

8. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit a vehicle other than a pedal cycle to proceed in those lengths of road specified in column 2 in Schedule 2 other than in the direction specified in column 4

10. The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:-

### Schedule 1 Zone J

#### Part 2.1 – No Loading/ Unloading At Any Time

Renumber existing items 1-3 to 4-6 and add the following items:-

Item No.	Road	Side	Description
1	Argyle Road	North-west	From the north-eastern kerbline of Campbell Road northwards to the kerbline of Preston Road
2	Preston Road	West	From the northern kerbline of Argyle Road north-westwards to the southern kerbline of

			Dyke Road Drive.
3	Preston Road	West	From the northern kerblines of Dyke Road Drive north-westwards for a distance of 30 metres.

**Part 4.1 – Permit Parking Place Monday to Sunday – 9am to 8pm**

Delete the following items:

Item No.	Road	Side	Description
6	Argyle Road	North west	From a point 4.7 metres east of the north eastern kerblines of Campbell Road eastwards for a distance of 5.7 metres
7	Argyle Road	North west	From a point 17.2 metres east of the north eastern kerblines of Campbell Road eastwards for a distance of 10.5 metres

11. Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018

Add the following:-

1a	Argyle Road	North-west	From the northern kerblines of Campbell Road northwards to the southern kerblines of Preston Road
49a	Preston Road (A23)	West	(Two-way) From the northern kerblines of Argyle Road northwards to the southern kerblines of Dyke Road Drive, a distance of 105 metres.
49b	Preston Road (A23)	West	(Two-way) From the northern kerblines of Dyke Road Drive northwards for a distance of 30 metres.
