

**BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Driving and Various Restrictions) (New Road) Experimental Order 2020**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the “Brighton and Hove (Prohibition of Driving and Various Restrictions) (New Road) Experimental Order 2020”.
2. The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2020.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-
  - **“Authorised Person”** means an employee or agent of the Council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the Council under this Order;
  - **“Blue Badge Scheme”** means the national arrangement of parking concessions for disabled and blind persons as described in the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 (as amended);
  - **“Emergency services vehicle”** means a vehicle operated by the police, fire & rescue service or ambulance service;
  - **“Pedal cycle”** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
  - **“Motor Vehicle”** means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads subject to Section 20 Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;
  - **“Road marking”** means a traffic sign consisting of a line or mark or legend on the surface on the road of a size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - **“Traffic Signs Regulation and General Directions”** means the Traffic Signs Regulation and General Directions 2016 as amended from time to time;
