

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NOTICE is hereby given by Brighton & Hove City Council, pursuant to powers contained in Section 90A (I) of the Highway Act 1980 as amended, of its proposals to construct flat topped road humps and speed cushions in the following locations;

- Dyke Road Drive, Brighton – flat topped hump, 5 metres in length with a maximum height of 75mm
 1. North-westwards from a point 5m northwest from a point opposite lighting column No.4
- Dyke Road Drive, Brighton - speed cushions, 3.5 metres in length with a maximum height of 65mm
 1. North-westwards from a point 8m northwest from a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 44 and 45
- Nizells Avenue, Hove – flat topped hump, 5 metres in length with a maximum height of 75mm
 1. Eastwards from a point 157m east of the eastern kerbline of Somerhill Road
 2. Westwards from a point 121m west of the western kerbline of Osmond Road / York Avenue
