The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below :-

BRIGHTON & HOVE VARIOUS CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2018 AMENDMENT ORDER NO. * 201* (ref: TRO-8a-2019)

New Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

At Any Time: To provide parking for disabled residents:- Tivoli Crescent (Zone A), Ditchling Gardens (Zone G), Crescent Road & Grantham Road (Zone J), Waterloo Street (Zone M), Eaton Gardens, Hova Villas & Livingstone Road (Zone N), Somerhill Road (Zone O), Hamilton Road (Zone Q), Freshfield Road (Zone S), Coleman Street (Zone V), Clifton Place & Sillwood Street (Zone Z)

Removal of Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

A number of bays are being removed, as they are no longer required by local residents, no longer on the ground or are duplicated on the consolidation order:- 13-14 Atlingworth Street (Zone C), 32 Hollingbury Road (Zone G), 33 & 40 Arundel Street, 131 Marine Parade & 42 Prince's Terrace (Zone H), 19-21 Grantham Road, (adj 124 Ditchling Road) Prince's Road & 125 Waldegrave Road (Zone J), 11 Clermont Terrace (Zone K), 19a Goldstone Road (Zone N), 13 Stanford Road (Zone Q), 56 Carlisle Road 15 Westbourne Street (Zone R), 50 St Luke's Road (Zone U), 63 Islingword Street, 81 Lincoln Street & 37 Washington Street (Zone V), 7, 23 & 29 Vernon Terrace (Zone Y)

Removal of Disabled Badge Holder's Parking Places Monday to Sunday – Maximum Stay 3 hours (No return within 1 hour) as they are no longer required or on the ground:- Melbourne Street (Zone V)

New Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

There are a number of advisory disabled bays within Brighton & Hove which are being used by non-Blue Badge holding motorists. It is proposed to make these bays legally enforceable by Civil Enforcement Officers to ensure they are available for Blue Badge holders only

At Any Time:- Beech Grove, Bolney Road, Byworth Close, Clarke Avenue, Crescent Drive North, Eastbrook Road, Elm Road, Exceat Close, Fernhurst Crescent, Flimwell Close, Godwin Road, Graham Avenue, Hangleton Way, Lincoln Road (Portslade), Martin Road, Midhurst Walk, Plymouth Avenue, Sherbourne Road, Spencer Avenue, Stanmer Villas, Staplefield Drive, The Crestway, Vale Road, Wayland Avenue, Whitehawk Crescent, Whitehawk Road & Wickhurst Road
