

What to put in your bin

You can use your garden waste bin for:

- Leaves
- Twigs
- Hedge cuttings
- Plants
- Grass
- Tree cuttings

You can also put fruit and vegetable peelings, tea bags and coffee grounds in your bin.

Putting any other materials, including plastic bags, into your garden waste bin will mean it won't be emptied.

We can only collect what's inside your bin, so please don't leave anything else – including extra garden waste – around or outside your bin as this won't be collected.

Household recycling sites

You can take larger tree branches and soil to either of our household recycling sites off Old Shoreham Road in Hove, and Wilson Avenue in Brighton.

You can also recycle many other materials at the centres, such as MDF, rubble, large and small electrical items (including energy saving and fluorescent light bulbs), textiles and paint.

CDs, DVDs and books are all donated to charity if taken to the Hove site.
