Beach, Street and Green Spaces Clean Up Terms and Conditions

(To be signed before any equipment is supplied)

To support community groups clean up the local community, Brighton and Hove City Council can provide supplies to local residents including, litter pickers, and bags. These supplies are free to use but must be used in accordance with the terms and conditions below.

We require volunteers to be over the age of 18 and will not supply support for those under this age unless volunteers under 18 are supervised by an adult who has signed up to these terms and conditions.

The requirements below are to keep you safe. The Council is grateful for the time you are willing to give to support your local community but not at the cost of injuring yourself or others. We want you to work safe and be safe. We must receive a signed copy of these terms and conditions before any equipment is supplied.

- 1. You are responsible for using the supplies safely and as directed by the instructions. You must behave sensibly and follow any safety instructions so as not to hurt or injure yourself or others.
- 2. If you have any pre-existing medical conditions, please do not volunteer if it will put your health at risk.
- 3. We provide materials only for the purposes intended to clean up litter from Brighton and Hove. Using them for anything else will be at the volunteers own risk.
- 4. If there is anything that is inaccessible by working on ground level then Brighton and Hove City Council would not support this work being undertaken and would advise that professional help is sought. If an area is hard to access and would involve any danger to yourself or others then please do not put yourself at risk. We would rather the problem remained than you were injured.
- 5. You must wear a high visibility vest at all times when using the supplies.
- 6. You must not sell, hire out or share the supplies with another individual without the Council's consent. For the avoidance of doubt the Council will not consent to another individual using the supplies without them signing these terms and conditions unless that individual is under 18, is conducting a litter activity only and is supervised by an adult who has signed up to these terms and conditions.
- 7. You are responsible for all of the supplies you borrow from the Council and must return the supplies to the Council after you have finished using them or if the Council requests their return. If you do not return or facilitate a return of the supplies within twenty one (21) days of the Council requesting this, the Council may hold you liable for the cost of the supplies.

- 8. In the absence of any negligence by us:
 - i. the use of the supplies are entirely at your own risk;
 - ii. you are liable for any damage, loss or injury directly or indirectly caused by your use of the supplies; and
 - iii. you will indemnify the Council in respect of all damage, loss or injury to person(s) or property and against all actions, suits, claims, demands, costs, charges and the expenses arising in connection with or occasioned directly or indirectly by your use of the supplies.
