

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Brighton & Hove (Stanmer Park) Various Restrictions and Off-Road Parking Order 2020 Amendment Order No.* 202* (TRO-15-2021)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

An amendment is required to the Stanmer Park Order to alter the provisions of the Lower Lodges car parks and Patchway A and B due to vehicles needing to park within bay markings, it is proposed to switch the provisions of these two car parks.

Currently Lower Lodges (east) has a restriction on the class of vehicle that can park there, this will alter so all vehicles are able to park. Lower Lodges (west) was for all vehicles, but to ensure these are able to fit within the parking bays it will now be just for motor cars and motorbikes which do not exceed 1.99 metres in height. The same applies with regards to Patchway B has a restriction on the class of vehicle that can park there, this will alter so all vehicles are able to park.

The order will allow Plumpton College at its absolute discretion to issue permits to its students and visitors to the College enabling them to park in the Patchway car park during term time. This will enable more flexible use of the Overflow spaces.

Replaces the existing drop off and pick up point near Stanmer House to limited waiting which enables people to park for a maximum 30 minutes.

The loading bay in the Walled Garden is being moved slightly to better location so that fire access can be maintained at Stanmer Museum Craft Workshop. The other bay in the area is being removed as it is not required.
