

# **BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## **Brighton & Hove (New Road, Brighton) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and Prohibition of Right-Turn) Order 2008 Amendment Order No.1 2021 (TRO-15-2020)**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021 made the above-named Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when it comes into operation on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2021 will make permanent the no entry except pedal cycles at North Street & New Road junction.

The changes described above were originally the subject of an experimental traffic Order that was advertised on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2020; Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Driving and Various Restrictions) (New Road) Experimental Order 2020, the no entry restriction described above will be the only part of the Experimental Order to be made permanent.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of this Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
