New Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

At Any Time: To provide parking for disabled residents:- Atlingworth Street, Freshfield Road, Park Street & Upper Rock Gardens (Zone C), Ashford Road & Hythe Road (Zone F), Trinity Street (Zone J), Brunswick Place (Zone M), The Drive (Zone N), Cowper Street & Sackville Gardens (Zone R), Bernard Road (Zone S), Ranelagh Villas (Zone T), Newhaven Street (Zone V), Montpelier Road, Regent Street & Victoria Street (Zone Z)

Removal of Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places
