ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Driving) (Brighton Station) Order 2021**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the "Brighton and Hove (Prohibition of Driving) (Brighton Station) Order 2021".
2. The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 2021.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-
  - "**Emergency Services Vehicle**" means a vehicle operated by the police, fire & rescue service or ambulance service;
  - "**Pedal Cycle**" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
  - "**Motor Vehicle**" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads subject to Section 20 Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;
4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated or re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
6. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or person authorised by the Council cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in those parts of road specified in columns 2 and 3 in Schedule 1 other than;
  - (a) a Pedal Cycle
  - (b) Vehicles in the service of or authorised by Network Rail or Govia Thameslink in pursuance of its duties.

- (c) Vehicles delivering to the convenience store at no.71-81 International House, Queens Road and if that vehicle cannot reasonably be used for the same purpose in any other part of the road.
- (d) Vehicles being used for the purpose of collecting refuse from the Brighton Station forecourt.
- (e) Emergency Services Vehicles being used in the course of an emergency.
