ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Brighton & Hove (Pre-book Electric Vehicle bays) Experimental Order 2022 (TRO-4-2022)

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) made the above-named experimental Order on the 19 January 2022 under the relevant provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the Act”) which comes into force on 7 February 2022 for a period not exceeding eighteen months. The effect of the Order will be to trial pre-bookable Electric Vehicle charging points in Pankhurst Avenue and Buxted Rise between 4pm and 8pm and at any other time the place will be for charging of any EV vehicle.

A copy of the experimental Order as made, a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be seen online at www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/current-tros.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to such indefinite continuation of the provisions of the experimental Order may within a period of six months from 7 February 2022, (or if this Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, six months from the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force) object in writing stating the grounds on which that objection is being made. Objections should be sent to the Executive Director Economy, Environment & Culture, Brighton & Hove City Council, c/o Parking Design & Implementation Team, G40 Hove Town Hall, Norton Road Hove, BN3 3BQ or by e-mail to TROcomment@brighton-hove.gov.uk or online via www.brighton-hove.gov.uk/current-tros. no later than 7 August 2022. In all cases the reference TRO-4-2022 should be quoted.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the experimental Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
