The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below :-

BRIGHTON & HOVE VARIOUS CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2018 AMENDMENT ORDER NO. * 202* (ref: TRO-29a-2022)

New Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

At Any Time: To provide parking for disabled residents:- Albion Street, St Johns Place & Windmill Street (Zone C), Dover Road (Zone F), Queensway (Zone I), Warleigh Road (Zone J), Kingsway (Zone L), St Aubyn's (Zone N), Palmeira Avenue (Zone O), York Villas (Zone Q), Rutland Gardens (Zone R), Bembridge Street, Bonchurch Road & May Road (Zone S), Kimberley Road (Zone U) & Bentham Road, Hanover Street & Southover Street (Zone V)

Removal of Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

A number of bays are being removed, as they are no longer required by local residents, no longer on the ground or are duplicated on the consolidation order:- Opposite 54 Windmill Street (Zone C), 39 Maldon Road (Zone E), 48 Crescent Road (Zone J), 23 Glynde Road (Zone S) & 92 Dewe Road (Zone U)

New Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

There are a number of advisory disabled bays within Brighton & Hove which are being used by non-Blue Badge holding motorists. It is proposed to make these bays legally enforceable by Civil Enforcement Officers to ensure they are available for Blue Badge holders only

At Any Time:- Ashurst Road, Auckland Drive, Birdham Road, Bramble Way, Cooksbrigde Road, Dean Gardens, Drove Crescent, Dudley Road, Egmont Road, Florence Avenue, Gladstone Road, Godwin Road, Hangleton Way, Hollingdean Terrace, Ladies Mile Road, Lambourne Road, Mackie Avenue, Moyne Close, Park Crescent (Rottingdean), Selsfield Drive, Shelldale Crescent, Southdown Road (Portslade), Stanmer Park Road, Stanmer Villas, Stanstead Crescent, Stephens Road, Warmdene Close, West Way & Whitehawk Crescent

Removal of Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places

A number of bays are being removed, as they are no longer required by local residents, no longer on the ground or on the controlled parking zone order:- 12 Denton Drive, 30 Hallyburton Road, 44 Meadway Crescent, 24 Moulsecomb Way, 32 Rustington Road, 144 The Avenue & 10 Warbleton Close
