

# **BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) proposes to make the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce various changes as detailed below:

### **Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (TRO-5a-2023)**

#### **Zone C –**

- Old Steine – Makes changes to existing waiting and parking restrictions to introduce no loading at any time, removal of taxi rank, shared parking, motorcycle bay and relocation of doctors’ bays and disabled bays.
- Introduces no loading at any time on part of Steine Street.

#### **Zone Z –**

- Old Steine – Makes changes to existing waiting and parking restrictions to introduce no loading at any time, removes paid parking, car club bay, time restricted taxi rank and one motorcycle bay. New taxi ranks and bus stands and relocates loading bays.
- Castle Square – removes loading bay on north side (for the installation of a bus stop clearway) and extends the length no loading at any time.
- Pool Valley – removes one public service vehicle parking bay to introduce new loading bay

### **Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-5b-2023)**

- Introduces a new mandatory cycle lane on Old Steine (northern carriageway) adjacent to the War Memorial.

### **Brighton & Hove Seafront (Various Restrictions) Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-5c-2023)**

- Marine Parade - removes paid parking bays, taxi rank and loading bay and introduces no loading at any time.
- Grand Junction Road - Introduces a new taxi rank and no loading at any time.
- Madeira Drive –updates description for loading bay.

### **Brighton & Hove (Bus Lanes) Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-5d-2023)**

Amends the current bus lanes, bus gates and routes and introduces bus lanes:

- Old Steine/Pavilion Parade – bus lane only at any time from just north of St James Street to just north of Pavilion Street
- Old Steine – bus lane at any time leading into Castle Square

## **Brighton & Hove (Valley Gardens) Traffic Management Order No.2 202\* (ref TRO-5e-2023)**

- Introduces a prohibition of driving on the section of Old Steine (western carriageway) which runs north from Castle Square northwards to Pavilion Parade/Old Steine
- Makes sections of the Old Steine one way
- No right turns from Old Steine into Steine Street, Old Steine section leading to Princes Street and Pavilion Street

## **Brighton & Hove (Madeira Drive) (One-Way) Order 2022 Amendment No.\* 202\* (TRO-5f-2023)**

- Madeira Drive to be made one-way eastbound from its junction with A259 - Grand Junction Road/Marine Parade

NOTICE is given that under Section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980 Brighton & Hove Council proposes to provide lengths of cycle tracks for the use of cyclists only, by the side of the highway in the Old Steine and leading to the A259 Grand Junction Road and Marine Parade and also cycle tracks on the A259 Grand Junction Road, Marine Parade and Madeira Drive.
