ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 22nd February 2023 made the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when they come into operation on 27th February 2023 will introduce various changes to the waiting or parking restrictions in the part or parts of the roads identified:

Some changes to the orders as originally proposed and advertised on 15th July 2022 are as follows:-

Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.1 2023

- Proposed Double Yellow Lines in North Lane - This has been withdrawn from the order.
- Proposed Double yellow lines at Junction of Woodland Way & Braybon Avenue – The double yellow lines in Woodland Way will be reduced to 5 metres.
- Proposed double yellow lines in Braybon Avenue at Junction with Old Farm Road – These have been reduced from 19 metres to 16 metres.
