

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) proposes to make the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce various changes as detailed below:

Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Schools Streets) Order 2021 Amendment Order No.* 202* (Ref: TRO-13a-2023)

- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm - Term Time Only except for access in Northease Drive from its junction with Poplar Avenue to its junction with Spencer Avenue to encourage active and sustainable travel.
- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm - Term Time Only except for access in Dale View from its junction with Summerdale Road northwards to its termination to encourage active and sustainable travel.

Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.* 202* (Ref: TRO-13b-2023)

- Introduction of double yellow lines on Northease Drive.
- The existing crossing point on Northease Drive to be extended into the carriageway to reduce the width of the carriageway to a single lane. Vehicle movement shall remain bi-directional through the crossing point with eastbound traffic giving way to westbound traffic through the Give Way point.

NOTICE is also given that the Council, pursuant to powers contained in Section 90A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, proposes to construct a flat top road hump (maximum height 75mm) at the following location:

- Northease Drive from a point 30.7 metres from the junction with Spencer Avenue eastwards for 6.8 metres.
- Spencer Avenue at its junction with Northease Drive eastwards for 4.3 metres.
