

# **BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## **HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) proposes to make the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce various changes as detailed below:

### **Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Schools Streets) Order 2021 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (Ref: TRO-14a-2023)**

- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm - Term Time Only except for access in Hertford Road from its junction with Hollingbury Place to its junction with Hollingbury Rise to encourage active and sustainable travel.

### **Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (Ref: TRO-14b-2023)**

- Introduce double yellow lines on Hertford Road near the school gates.

NOTICE is also given that the Council, pursuant to powers contained in Section 90A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 as amended, proposes to construct a flat top road hump (maximum height 75mm) at the following locations:

- Hertford Road from a point 19 metres from the junction with Hollingbury Place Northwards for 4 metres
- Hertford Road from a point 90 metres from the junction with Hollingbury Place Northwards for 6 metres
- Hertford Road from a point 168 metres from the junction with Hollingbury Place Northwards for 4 metres
