**Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018  
Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-17-2023)**

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

This is in line with the Council's commitment to reducing emissions and encouraging the take-up of electric vehicles in the city, the Council has committed to providing electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure to meet the needs of EV drivers.

In high-capacity areas, in order to ensure re-charging spaces are available for EV drivers and not blocked by other vehicles, the Council intends to make some of the parking areas adjacent to residential lamp post column chargers mandatory EV re-charging bays for permit holders only.
