Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Schools Streets) Order 2021 Amendment Order No.1 2023 (Ref: TRO-11-2023)

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ('the Council') has on 3rd May 2023 made the Order named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when it comes into operation on 9th May 2022 will make the following changes:

- Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm - Term Time Only except for access in Eridge Road to encourage active and sustainable travel.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of this Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
