

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 21 June 2023 made the Order named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when it comes into operation on 26 June 2023 will introduce various changes as detailed below:

Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.8 2023 (ref: TRO-10-2023)

Zone R

Introduce new electric vehicle charging points for permit holders only Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours) in:

Alpine Road, Bolsover Road, Byron Street, Coleridge Street, Langdale Road, Payne Avenue, Pembroke Avenue, Portland Road, Poynter Road, Rutland Road and Wordsworth Street

Existing parking restrictions will be amended to accommodate the new bays.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
