

BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 21 June 2023 made the Order named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when it comes into operation on 26 June 2023 will introduce various changes as detailed below:

Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.7 2023 (ref: TRO-6a-2023)

Zone J

Relocate electric vehicle charging point in Cleveland Road and for point to be made for permit holders only Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours).

Zone N

Introduce new electric vehicle charging points for permit holders only Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours) in:

Connaught Road, First Avenue, Goldstone Road, Goldstone Villas, St Aubyns, Seafield Road, Tisbury Road and Ventnor Villas.

Existing charging points in Eaton Gardens and Selborne Road to be made for permit holders only Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours).

Zone S

Electric vehicle charging point in Pankhurst Avenue to become for permit holders only Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours).

Zone V

Relocate electric vehicle charging point in Carlyle Street.

Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment No.5 2023 (ref: TRO-6b-2023)

Electric charging point in Buxted Rise to become an at any time bay Maximum Stay 24 hours (No return within 12 hours).

Existing parking restrictions will be amended to accommodate the new bays.

Please note the bays in Pankhurst Avenue and Buxted Rise are currently part of an experimental order (TRO-4-2022) for the pre-booked electrical vehicle charging bays and this experimental order will be withdrawn.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose
