Brighton & Hove (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 Amendment No.1 2023 (TRO-25-2023)

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 5 July 2023 made the Order named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when it comes into operation on 17 July 2023 will introduce weekend tariffs to Norton Road Car Park and extend the operational hours from 9am to 8pm to 8am to 8pm at Black Rock, King Alfred, Marine Cliffs and West Street (Rottingdean) Car Parks.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose
