**Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018
Amendment Order No.* 202* (ref: TRO-33-2023)**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below: -

It was agreed at Budget Council on 23 February 2023 to increase Paid Parking fees across the city. The proposals to change parking zones C, H, J and N from low tariff areas to high tariff areas were included in the overall budget package approved at Budget Council in February 2023 reflecting both sustainable transport policy and financial objectives.

These were then amended at Strategy, Finance and City Regeneration Committee on 13 July 2023.

High Tariff will change to Low Tariff for all on-street parking charges within Zones C, H and J. In Zone N the majority of the zone will be in the Low Tariff with the exception of the Kingsway which will be Medium Tariff.
