

# **BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 5 July 2023 made the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when they come into operation on 4 September 2023 will introduce various changes as detailed below:

## **Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.12 2023 (TRO-34a-2022)**

- Amends loading bays on Western Road.

## **Brighton & Hove (Traffic Management) (Western Road area, Brighton) Order No.2 2023 (TRO-34c-2022)**

- Amend the Prohibition of Driving at Marlborough Street into Western Road to allow pedal cycles.

### **Modification**

Some changes to the orders as originally proposed and advertised on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022 are as follows:

The proposed loading restriction on TRO-34a-2022 will not go ahead at this time. TRO-34b-2022 which made amendments to the one-way traffic in the Western Road area will also not go ahead at this time.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
