

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984  
BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL**

**Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles & One Way) (Balfour Primary)  
Experimental Order 2023 (ref: TRO-34-2023)**

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles & One-Way) (Balfour Primary) Experimental Order 2023 and shall come into operation on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September 2023.
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:-
  - “**Bus**” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
  - “**Pedal cycle**” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
3. The Council’s Executive Director Economy, Environment & Culture or any person authorised by him is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated or re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
6. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle (not including buses and pedal cycles) to proceed in those lengths of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order other than in the direction specified in the adjoining section of column 3 of that Schedule except in the case of a vehicle in the course of an emergency for fire service, ambulance service or police purposes or a vehicle in the service of a local authority in the course of road cleansing or gully emptying.

7. The Brighton & Hove (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Schools Street) Order 2021 Amendment Order No.1 2022 is amended as follows:

**Schedule 1**

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles Monday to Friday 8.15am to 9.15am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm -Term Time Only except for access**

Add the following:-

8. The Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 is amended as follows:-

**Schedule 1 Zone F**

**Part 3.1 - No Stopping Restrictions Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm on School Entrance Markings except August**

Delete the following items:-

3	Balfour Road	North-West	Balfour Primary School. From a point 1.5 metres north of the shared property boundary of numbers 132 and 134 Balfour Road, north-eastwards for 30 metres	F
