**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

**Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes  
Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (TRO-31-2023)**

- Proposed double yellow lines in Brentwood Crescent, Brentwood Road, Dale View, Downland Road, Gableson Avenue, Gleton Avenue, Haywards Road, Manor Close, Morecambe Road, Oakdene Close, Oakdene Crescent, Old School Place, Portfield Avenue, Ryelands Drive, Selsfield Drive, Stapley Road, Tangmere Road, The Byway, Tongdean Lane & Warren Rise
- Proposed extension to double yellow lines in Cedar Gardens, Dale Drive, Wickhurst Close, Withdean Court Avenue & Woodland Drive

This is to improve visibility and safety for all road users.

- Proposed removal of double yellow lines in Shenfield Way

Double yellow lines are no longer required.

- Vale Avenue - Patcham (section near bypass)

Clarifying the description of double yellow lines on the existing order (no change on ground)

- Proposed single yellow line in Brentwood Crescent & Selham Close

To prevent obstruction for all road users and to allow access for emergency services and refuse vehicles.

- Removal of Limited Waiting for 2 hours (no return within 1 hour) Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm in Newtown Road

The restriction was not implemented and is no longer required.

- Amending disabled parking bay in Hollingdean Terrace

Clarifying the description on the existing order (no change on ground)

- Relocating disabled bay in Selham Drive

Relocating disabled bay to a more suitable location

- Proposed disabled parking bays in Auckland Drive, Barcombe Road, Beechers Road, Bellingham Crescent, Bexhill Road, Birdham Road, Bolney Road, Cedars Gardens, Chichester Close (Hove), Colbourne Avenue, Dale Crescent, Drove Crescent, Flint Close, Godwin Road, Hangleton Close, Hardwick Road, Hollingbury Rise, Mill Rise, Plymouth Avenue, Ridge Close, Southall Avenue, Stanley Road (Portslade), Stanmer Park Road, Stonery Close, The Avenue, The Crestway, Valley Road, Westfield Crescent & Wickhurst Rise

To provide a disabled parking bay for a resident in the vicinity.

- Removal of disabled parking bays in Beal Crescent, Beatty Avenue, Carden Crescent, Denton Drive, Drove Crescent, Fairfield Gardens, Hardwick Road, Hawthorn Way, Nevil Road (Hove), Roundway, Sherbourne Road, Stonecroft Close, Valley Road

The bay is being removed as no longer required.
