

# **BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## **Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (TRO-36-2023)**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ('the Council') proposes to make the Order named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce the following:

### Spring Street, Brighton

- Will change the two current Disabled Badge Holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 6pm into Disabled Badge Holders parking Monday to Sunday maximum stay 3 hours (no return within 1 hour), it will also introduce a new Disabled Badge Holders parking bay (double bay) at any time on the west side south of the junction with Hampton Street.
- It will remove the current single yellow line (east side) and replace it with a stretch of double yellow lines near the junction with Western Road (to allow for a turning area) and the remainder will become shared permit and paid parking bays.

### Crown Street, Brighton

- Will introduce a new disabled badge holders parking bay (double bay) Monday to Sunday maximum stay 3 hours (no return within 1 hour) on west side near junction with Western Road
- Will remove the current single yellow line on the west side and replace with permit holders only parking.

### Western Road, Brighton

- Will introduce a loading bay at any time – west of Hampton Street
