Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.* 202* (TRO-36-2023)

STATEMENT OF REASONS

On 21 July 2021, the Council's Environment, Transport and Sustainability Committee approved designs for changes to Western Road. The changes are intended to improve the street for those using the area to shop and travel through on foot, by bus or by bike. This Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) provides confirmation of the additional loading bay west of Hampton Place which was included on the approved plans. Additional opportunities have also been identified to improve the existing parking layout on Crown Street and Spring Street.

Parking

The following amendments to the current parking layout on Spring Street and Crown Street are proposed. The reason for these changes is to remove redundant single yellow lines and use the space to increase parking capacity in the area and allow for a bin storage facility.

The proposed changes are as follows:

- Introduction of double yellow lines for a bin storage facility on the eastern side of Crown Street, north of its junction with Western Road. This will provide refuse and recycling in one place.
- Introduction of a double disabled bay (Disabled Badge Holders only Monday to Sunday maximum stay 3 hours (no return within 1 hour)) on the western side of Crown Street, north of its junction with Western Road.
- Introduction of Permit Holder Only bays (Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm) on the western side of Crown Street to replace current single yellow line.
- Introduction of a double disabled bay (Disabled Badge Holders only at any time) on the western side of Spring Street, just south of its junction with Hampton Street to replace current double yellow lines. The current disabled bays just north of Western Road will have the current restriction (Monday to Sunday 9am to 6pm) changed to Monday to Sunday maximum stay 3 hours (no return within 1 hour)
- Introduction of Shared Permit Holder and Paid Parking bays (Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm) on the eastern side of Spring Street, north of its junction with Western Road to replace single yellow line.
- Introduction of double yellow lines on the eastern side of Spring Street to replace current single yellow line and provide turning space.

In total, there will be an increase of four Disabled Badge Holders bays. Two on Spring Street and two on Crown Street. This will give blue badge holders more parking provision close to Western Road.

In total, there will be an increase of two Permit Holder Only bays on Crown Street and six Shared Permit Holder and Paid bays on Spring Street.

Loading

It is proposed to add a loading bay outside Nos.138-140 Western Road, between Hampton Place and Montpelier Road. The reason for this is to provide additional opportunities for servicing of premises to take place off of the carriageway and reduce delays for traffic including buses.
