## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ('the Council') proposes to make the Orders named below under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

### **Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-38a-2023)**

This Order if it comes into force will introduce bike hangars for secure pedal cycle parking provision. It will also amend existing waiting and parking restrictions to allow for the installation of the hangars.

The hangars will be in the following locations:

- Zone A - Compton Road (2 hangar locations)
- Zone C – Atlingworth Street, Freshfield Street, Livingstone Street, Queen’s Park Terrace, & Sutherland Road (2 hangars together)
- Zone F – Balfour Road (2 hangar locations) & Osborne Road (2 Hangar locations)
- Zone H – College Road (2 hangar locations) & Sudeley Street
- Zone J – Chester Terrace, Mayo Road, Preston Drive, Prince’s Road, Richmond Road, St Andrew’s Road & Warleigh Road (2 hangar locations)
- Zone K – Home Road & Lauriston Road (2 hangar locations)
- Zone M – Brunswick Road, Palmeira Square (2 hangar locations) & Waterloo Street
- Zone N – Brooker Street (2 hangar locations), Livingstone Road & The Drive
- Zone O – Cissbury Road, Furze Hill (2 hangar locations), Lorna Road, Silverdale Road & Wilbury Crescent
- Zone R – Shakespeare Street & Sheridan Terrace
- Zone S – Bonchurch Road, Carisbrooke Road (2 hangar locations) & Queens Park Road (2 hangar locations)
- Zone U – Ewhurst Road, Kimberley Road & Ladysmith Road
- Zone V – Coleman Street (2 hangar locations), Islingword Place, Lincoln Street & Southover Street (2 hangar locations)
- Zone Y – Compton Avenue (2 hangars together), Kingsbury Road & Windlesham Gardens
- Zone Z – Bedford Square (2 hangars together), Norfolk Place & Sillwood Road (2 hangar locations)

### **Brighton & Hove Outer Areas (Waiting, Loading and Parking) and Cycle Lanes Consolidation Order 2018 Amendment Order No.\* 202\* (ref: TRO-38b-2023)**

This Order if it comes into force will introduce bike hangars for secure pedal cycle parking provision in the following locations:

- Hollingdean Street (2 hangars together)
