Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2024 Amendment Order No.1 2024 (ref: TRO-2-2024)

NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 15 May 2024 made the Order named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and Traffic Management Act 2004 which when it comes into operation on 20 May 2024 will introduce various changes to the waiting or parking restrictions in the part or parts of the roads identified:

Controlled Parking Zone C

- **Albion Street** – reduce double yellow lines and increase permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm
- **Dorset Street** – reduce double yellow lines and increase permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm
- **Egremont Place** – reduce double yellow lines and increase the permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm
- **George Street** - reduce double yellow lines and introduce a new paid parking bay Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff short term – 2 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **John Street** – reduce double yellow lines and extend existing permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm and remove motorcycle bay and double yellow line and extend shared parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff medium term – 4 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **Kingswood Street** – reduce double yellow lines and extend paid parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff short term – 2 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **Morley Street** – reduce double yellow lines and introduce/extend shared parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff short term – 2 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **Somerset Street** – reduce double yellow lines and introduce new shared parking bay Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff long term – 11 hours
- **Upper Rock Gardens** – reduce double yellow lines and increase permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm

Controlled Parking Zone F

- **Balfour Road** – reduce double yellow lines and increase permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm

Controlled Parking Zone H

- **Beresford Road** – reduce double yellow lines, relocate disabled badge holders only bay and extend permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm
- **Church Place** – reduce double yellow lines and increase shared parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff medium term – 4 hours (no return within 4 hours)

- **Paston Place** – reduce double yellow lines and introduce a new shared parking bay Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff short term – 2 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **Rock Grove** – remove double yellow lines and increase shared parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff medium term – 4 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **St George's Road** – reduce double yellow lines and increase shared parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm, low tariff short term – 2 hours (no return within 4 hours)
- **Whitehawk Hill Road** – reduce double yellow lines and increase permit holders parking Monday to Sunday 9am to 8pm

Modifications

Following comments to the order as originally proposed and advertised on 16th February 2024; Upper Bedford Street and Sudeley Street proposals will not be proceeding.

The notice of proposals relating to this Order referred to it as amending the Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2018. The provisions of the 2018 Order have now been consolidated into the Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2024. The title and drafting of this Order have been altered accordingly but the effect of the Order is identical to that given in the notice of proposals.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
