

**WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**BRIGHTON (DOWNLAND) DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT**

**THE BRIGHTON & HOVE LEGAL EVENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2024**

This Order is made by Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) under section 53(2)(a) and (b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to the Council that the Hove Definitive Map and Statement requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in section 53(3)(a) (iii) and specified in the Schedule to this Order. Namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a new right of way has been created over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

The Council is the only local authority whose area includes land to which this Order relates.

The Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 6<sup>th</sup> September 2024
2. The Hove Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described the Schedule and shown on the plan attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as “The Brighton & Hove (Woodland Drive Hove FP H25) Legal Event Modification Order 2024”.

FP H25	[TQ28702 07102 Woodland Drive running easterly for 54m to TQ28648 07100 at Three Cornered Copse]	The Council accepted this footpath as a public right of way by way of maintaining it as such, dating back to at least 1998. The Council has added a handrail and way marker, and has tarmacked the path. The public have confirmed they have used the route openly and freely without permission as of right for at least 20 years.


