**Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2024
Amendment Order No.* 202* (ref: TRO-37-2024)**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below: -

Following a recent citywide parking review, one recommendation was to consider the introduction of paid parking within light touch parking zones which are undersubscribed in terms of the number of permits issued. A series of parking surveys to determine vehicle occupancy in several roads within Zones L, P, W, X and 11 was undertaken – the results of which highlighted low levels of vehicle occupancy. The council is therefore proposing to introduce small sections of paid parking for visitors to the area whilst retaining sufficient parking provision for residents.
