NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ('the Council') proposes to make the Orders named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if it comes into force will in Chiltington Way introduce a one-way southbound (except pedal cycles) from Effingham Close to Falmer Avenue it will also introduce a new school keep clear at the northern entrance to the Saltdean Primary School.
