STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below: -

The changes being proposed for Chiltington Way are a result of requests by Saltdean Primary School, local residents, concerned parents and local councillors about dangerous and inconsiderate driving. This includes:

- Drivers mounting the kerb and parking on pavements, when children are present
- Drivers reversing long distances or driving long distances along the pavement
- Vehicles parked in or blocking residents' driveways
- Vehicles blocking Saltdean Primary School's emergency vehicle access driveway

The proposed one-way and new school keep clear follow public consultations and are designed to relieve the conditions described above and improve the safety and comfort of children and families accessing Saltdean Primary School, as well as local residents, particularly during school pick-up and drop-off times
