

**BRIGHTON & HOVE CITY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

Brighton & Hove (Chiltington Way) (One-Way) Order 202* (TRO-6a-2025)

Brighton & Hove City Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 and 19 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall be cited as the “Brighton and Hove (Chiltington Way) (One-Way) Order 202*”.
2. The provisions of this Order will come into operation on the ** day of ***** 202*.
3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them: -
 - **“Emergency services vehicle”** means a vehicle operated by the police, fire & rescue service or ambulance service;
 - **“Pedal cycle”** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
4. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order unless specified otherwise.
5. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle except a pedal cycle to proceed in those lengths of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order other than in the direction specified in the adjoining section of column 3 of that Schedule.
6. Articles 5 shall not apply vehicles in the course of an emergency for fire service, ambulance service or police purposes.
7. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, and existing when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on movement by vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
