NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council ('the Council') proposes to make the Orders named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which if they come into force will introduce the following on London Road (A23):

- Will reduce the length of 40mph speed limit which currently starts just north of the southern access of Old London Road to a new starting point just north of the junction with Brangwyn Crescent. The length south of this point will be restricted to the national speed limit of 30mph (by presence of streetlights).
- Install a new southbound bus lane to be installed approximately between Brangwyn Crescent and The Woodlands/ South Woodlands
- Amend the cycle lane to allow installation of new crossing point and new bus lane.

NOTICE is given that the Council pursuant to powers contained in Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act propose to establish a signalised pedestrian crossing over London Road north of its junction with the southern access to Old London Road.
