NOTICE is hereby given that Brighton & Hove City Council (“the Council”) has on 10 December 2025 made the Orders named above under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which when they come into operation on 13 December 2025 will update the articles of the orders to allow for the introduction of paperless (virtual) permits. It will also remove the transferable visitor permits but reintroduces a free 1-day visitor permit to the Event Day areas and amends the number of permits allowed to be issued.
